AROUND THE PAC-12

Hot Huskies. . . WASHINGTON has won five straight and eight of its last nine games to take a one-game lead in the Pac-12 standings. The Huskies now hit the road for five of their last seven games.

Buffaloes Roll. . . COLORADO has won five of its last six games and is keeping pace with CALIFORNIA and WASHINGTON in the standings. Like Washington, the Buffaloes now leave the comforts of the home court to play five of their last seven on the road.

Defending the Home Court. . . To date, the home team has posted a 46-20 record (.697) in Pac-12 play, and are 117-42 (.736) overall at home. . . The best cumulative home court record in league history came in 1991 when league teams went 64-26 (.711) at home.

BANK OF THE WEST PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KYLE FOGG, ARIZONA - PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.— ARIZONA guard Kyle Fogg has been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Men's Basketball Player of the Week for Jan. 30-Feb. 5, Commissioner Larry Scott announced Monday.

The senior led Arizona to a sweep of the Bay Area schools last week, starting with a 78-74 win over California on Thursday. Fogg put up 23 points via 8-of-14 (.571) shooting from the field and 5-of-6 (.833) three-point shooting. The Brea, Calif., native also added four assists, three rebounds, two steals and a block in the close victory.

On Saturday, Fogg tallied 14 points—with nine of those points coming from three-pointers—and sank 5-of-6 (.833) free throws to lift the Wildcats over Stanford, 56-43. Fogg also posted four rebounds, four assists, one block and one steal. Fogg locked down on defense in both contests, with his primary defensive assignment in each game combining to shoot 8-of-28 (.286) from the field against him.

For the week, Fogg averaged 18.5 points on 11-for-23 shooting (.478) from the field and 8-for-13 (.615) from three-point land, contributed 3.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists, and added three steals and two blocks.

This is Fogg's first career Pac-12 Player of the Week honor and the 83rd all-time selection for Arizona.

PAC-12 POINTS

- ARIZONA's defense limited Stanford to 25.4 percent shooting (16-of-63) in its win over the Cardinal. Not only was it the lowest opposing field goal percentage of the season, but it was the lowest such figure since Dec. 2, 2000, when Arizona limited Saint Mary's to just 25.0 percent shooting (15-of-60) in a 101-41 UA win. The effort Saturday helped drop UA's overall field goal percentage defense figure to 39.8 percent, which is tied with Colorado.
- Arizona defends the three, too. . . The Wildcats extend their defense to beyond the arc as they lead the league in three-point field goal defense (26.7 percent). That figure ranks fourth in the nation.
- Huskies have won eight of their last nine. . . WASHINGTON has three of the top eight scorers in league - freshman G **Tony Wroten** (16.7 ppg/3rd), sophomore G **Terrence Ross** (15.2 ppg/5th) and sophomore G **C.J. Wilcox** (13.9 ppg/8th). . . Ross has scored in double digits in each of the last 13 games and in 22 of 23 games this season.
- OREGON STATE junior G **Jared Cunningham** has posted double digits in the scoring column in 15 straight games. . . Cunningham continues to lead the Pac-12 in scoring (18.0) and steals (2.8, fourth in the nation).
- OREGON STATE ranks second in the nation in steals (10.3 per game). That number got a big boost Saturday when junior F **Joe Burton** grabbed a career-best six steals vs. Utah and Jared Cunningham added four thefts in contributing to the team's 16 steals for the game.
- CALIFORNIA senior F **Harper Kamp** is on the verge of reaching a couple of statistical milestones. He needs 19 points to reach 1,000 points for his career, and will need to pull down seven more rebounds to reach 500 career rebounds. Kamp averages 10.0 ppg/5.0 rpg and is one of four Bears to average double digits, joining **Allen Crabbe** (15.9 ppg), **Jorge Gutierrez** (14.1 ppg) and **Justin Cobbs** (12.7 ppg).
- OREGON senior G **Devoe Joseph** has scored in double digits in nine straight games, averaging 18.0 points during that stretch.
- COLORADO has won 10 straight home games and remains unbeaten at home in Pac-12 play (7-0). . . CU is 13-1 at home this season and 31-3 at home under CU head coach **Tad Boyle**.
- WASHINGTON STATE junior F **Brock Motum** has averaged 28.3 points in last three games (34 at Arizona State, 26 against USC, 25 against UCLA). . . He has scored 20-plus points in seven games this season and in his last three. . . Over the last seven games, Motum is averaging 21.6 points/7.7 rebounds, shooting 53-of-87 (.609) from the field, and 38-of-44 (.864) from the line.
- Swat patrol... UTAH's **Jason Washburn** eight blocked shots vs. Oregon State, while COLORADO's **André Roberson** had seven blocked shots vs. Oregon. Roberson had nine blocks for the week, giving him a league-leading 43 rejections (1.9 per game). . . Roberson continues to pace the Pac-12 in rebounding, averaging 11.2 per game (fifth in the nation). His +3.2 rebound margin over the league's next rebounder (Washington's Aziz N'Diaye and Arizona's Solomon Hill are at 8.0 rpg) is the widest margin for a rebound leader since 1982 when California's Mark McNamara (12.6 rpg) had a +4.0 margin over Stanford's John Revelli (8.6 rpg).
- UCLA sophomore C **Joshua Smith** was impressive on the Bruins road swing through Washington as he averaged 21.5 points and 7.0 rebounds. He shot 17-of-22 (.773) from the field in posting a career-best 24 points at Washington and 19 points at Washington State. He upped his season field goal percentage to 59.6 percent, which ranks third in the league.
- OREGON STATE sophomore F **Devon Collier** has scored in double figures in eight straight games, averaging 14.9 points and shooting 42-of-67 (.627) during that stretch. . . UCLA sophomore F **David Wear** has posted double figures in seventh straight, averaging 12.6 points and while shooting 35-of-55 (.636) from the field.
- USC sophomore F **Garrett Jackson** is averaging 15.3 points over the last three games. During that three-game stretch, he averaged 31.7 minutes per game. Prior to that three-game stretch, Jackson was averaging 4.7 points in 16.5 minutes per contest through the first 21 games of the season.
- ARIZONA STATE junior forward **Trent Lockett** (13.9 ppg/6.4 rpg) has missed the last six games due to an ankle injury. Lockett's absence has impacted the Sun Devils. Here's a comparison of the team numbers in the 17 games prior to his injury, and the six games he's missed:

UCLA TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES--The UCLA Bruins are picked to finish first in the 2011-12 Pac-12 Conference men's basketball race, according to a poll of media members who cover Pac-12 men's basketball.

UCLA, led by junior All-Conference forward Reeves Nelson (13.9 ppg/9.1 rpg), tallied 14 first-place votes and narrowly edges out CALIFORNIA and ARIZONA. California, paced by senior All-Conference guard Jorge Gutierrez (14.6 ppg/4.5 apg) and senior forward Harper Kamp (14.2 ppg/5.6 rpg) picked up 13 first-place votes and is tabbed for second. Arizona, the reigning regular-season Conference champion, pulled in the remaining 11 first-place votes and are picked to finish third.

WASHINGTON, the defending Pac-12 Tournament champion, is slotted fourth, followed by OREGON in fifth and STANFORD sixth. The second half of the predicted race starts with USC edging out OREGON STATE for seventh with ARIZONA STATE picked ninth. COLORADO and WASHINGTON STATE are tied for tenth, followed by UTAH.
